



Albany Pine Bush Preserve Fishing, Hunting & Trapping *April 1, 2010 thru Sept. 30, 2010*

Trailhead 1 area: East of State Rt. 155, west of Rapp Rd., west of I87 and north of NYS Thruway

- **Hunting:** restricted to archery-only small game hunting. **Note:** Closed to hunting Tuesday thru Friday from 8 am to 3 pm during periods May 4 – June 13 and Sept. 7 – Oct. 1.
- **Trapping:** closed this period
- **Fishing:** no fishing opportunities occur in this area

Trailhead 2 area: East of Rapp Rd., west of I87 and north of NYS Thruway

- **Hunting:** restricted to archery-only small game hunting
- **Trapping:** closed this period
- **Fishing:** open to fishing consistent with DEC fishing regulations. Please use non-toxic jigs and sinkers.

Trailhead 3 area: East of I87 and north of I90

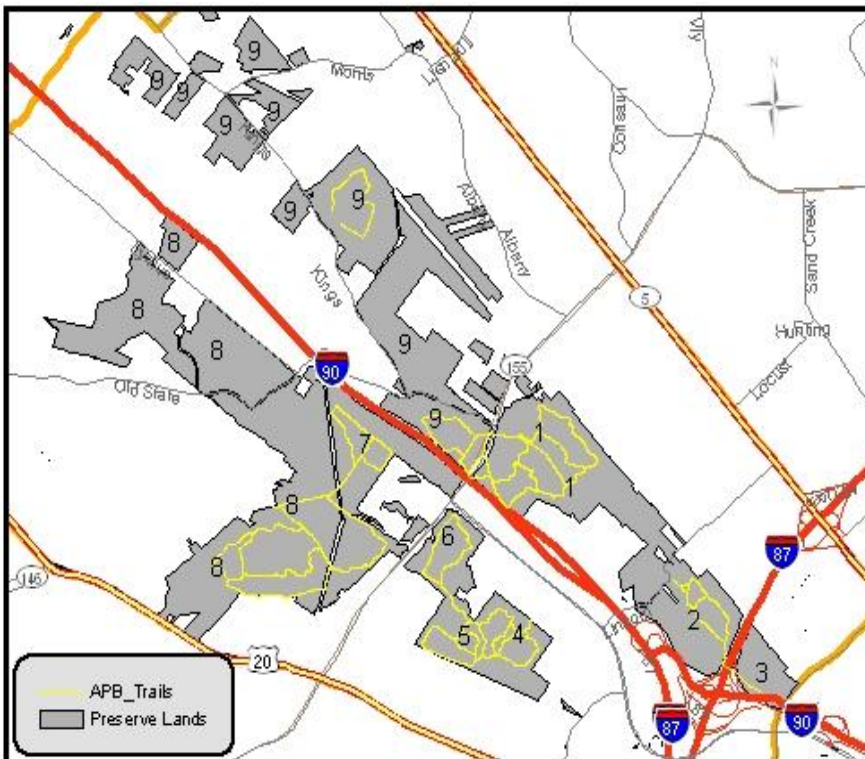
- **Hunting:** closed to hunting this period
- **Trapping:** closed this period
- **Fishing:** open to fishing consistent with DEC fishing regulations. Please use non-toxic jigs and sinker

Trailheads 4, 5 & 6 area: East of State Rt. 155 and south of Washington Ave. Ext.

- **Hunting:** restricted to archery-only small game hunting
- **Trapping:** closed this period
- **Fishing:** no fishing opportunities occur in this area

Trailheads 7 & 8 area: West of State Rt. 155 and south of NYS Thruway

- **Hunting:** open consistent with DEC & Pine Bush regulations. Please use non-toxic shot.
- **Trapping:** closed this period
- **Fishing:** open, but few fishing opportunities exist in this area

Trailhead 9 area: West of State Rt. 155 and north of NYS Thruway

- Hunting:** open consistent with DEC & Pine Bush regulations. Please use non-toxic shot.
- **Trapping:** closed this period
 - **Fishing:** open, but few fishing opportunities exist in this area

Separate guidelines will be issued by August 1, 2010 for hunting and trapping opportunities during the period October 1, 2010 to March 31, 2011.
