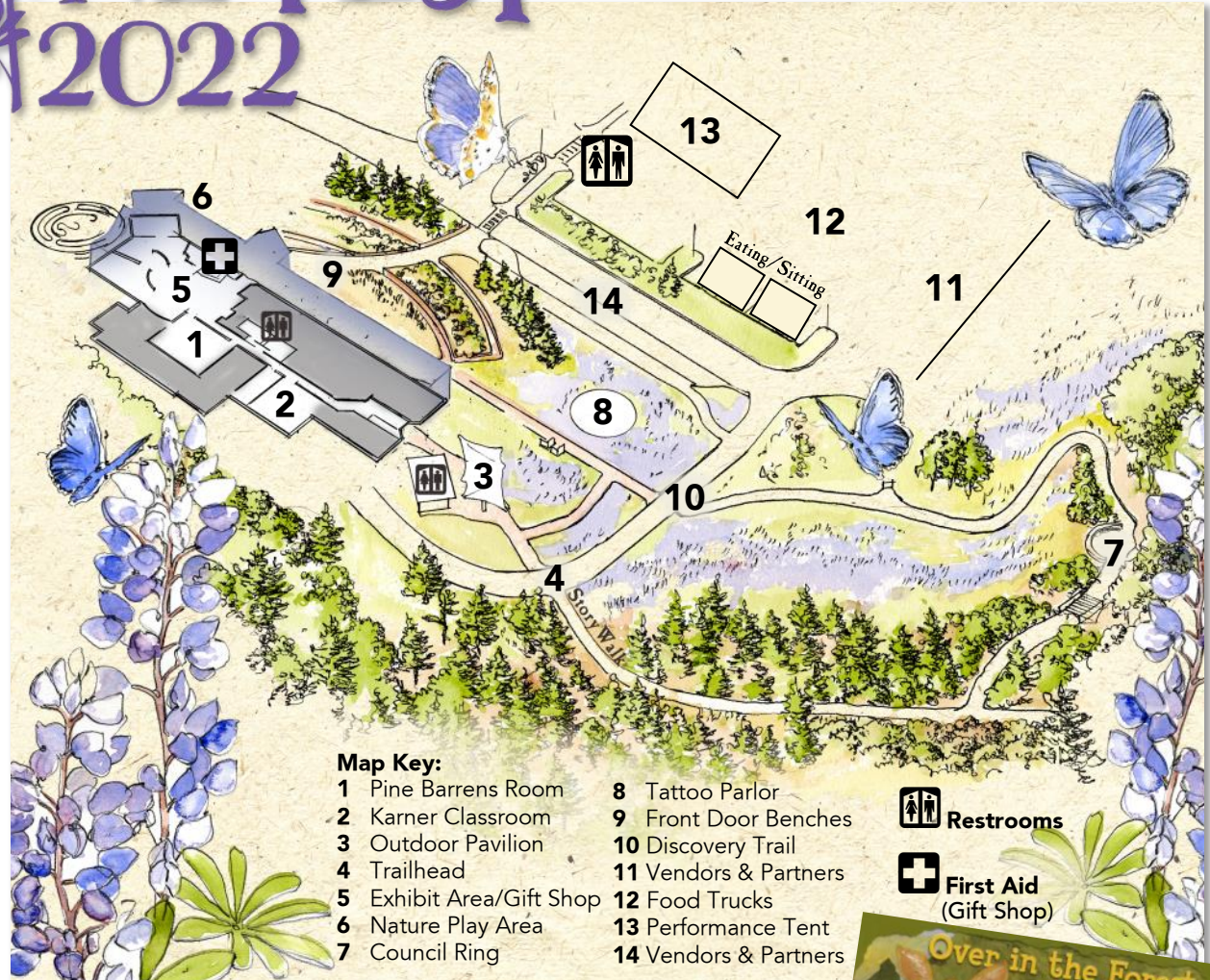
StoryWalk® (4) Walk the trail and read *Over in the Forest*
