Albany Pine Bush Preserve Commission (APBPC) Education Program Fee Guidelines

Beginning September 1, 2015, school (grades pre-K – 12), college, and special interest group (Scouts, clubs, etc.) fees for both on-site and outreach (off-site) guided programs are as follows:

Guided

- The fee for all guided programs is \$3 per participant; teachers and chaperones attend free.
- Minimum group size of eight participants (or minimum payment of \$24.00 with fewer participants) is required for guided programs.
- Payment is required the day of the program. If other payment arrangements are needed, please inform Education Staff at least 2 weeks in advance.
- Program fee waiver is available to eligible groups that qualify for the 40% free lunch program.

Self-guided

- Self-guided groups attend free of charge.
- Self-guided groups have the option of a 15 minute welcome and introduction by an APBPC staff member. To request an introduction, groups must provide a two week notice.
- We cannot accommodate self-guided groups larger than 75 people.
- Groups using the trails must be no larger than 24 people. Groups with 25 or more must either apply for a temporary revocable permit (TRP) through the APBPC or plan to divide the group into smaller groups for hiking.

Seminars & Workshops

- The fee for seminars and workshops is a flat rate of \$50.00, due on the day of the program.

Active Research Partners
